- **From the Genoa Cristoforo Colombo airport:** Take the Volabus from the airport, which will bring you to Genova Piazza Principe train station. From there, you can take a metro get off at the Sarzano/Sant'Agostino station.
- **From the Genova Piazza Principe train station:** take a metro towards Dinegro get off at the Sarzano/Sant'Agostino station.
- **From the Genova Brignole train station:** take a metro towards Brin get off at the Sarzano/Sant'Agostino station.
- **From the Sarzano/Sant'Agostino metro station:** it is about 3-minute walk to Via Santa Croce.
