- From the Genoa Cristoforo Colombo airport: Take the Volabus from the airport, which will bring you to Genova Piazza Principe train station. From there, you can take a metro get off at the Sarzano/Sant'Agostino station.
- From the Genova Piazza Principe train station: take a metro towards Dinegro get off at the Sarzano/Sant'Agostino station.
- From the Genova Brignole train station: take a metro towards Brin get off at the Sarzano/Sant'Agostino station.
